AS91880 - Develop a digital media outcome

Brief

Create a web page on a well-known New Zealand personality. This may be in the area of sport, entertainment, art, literature or science. Although you only need to create one web page, it must be designed as if it is part of a larger web site.

Page must be designed according to standard website layout guidelines and all information blocks must be placed inside the appropriate containers. Also correct hierarchy of headings must be observed. At least one image must be provided, which must be suitably presented.

The display must be designed to ensure comfortable reading and must be optimised for the visually impaired. Provisions must be made for users to alter the display to suit their own viewing needs.

Navigation facilities must be provided for ease of movement within the page itself

Data for the page must be collected from at least three different sources, and at least one should be a non-website source if possible. All sources must be clearly acknowledged, and for web sources a link back to the original information must be provided.
